TEACHING ENGLISH TO STUDENTS OF OTHER LANGUAGES (TESOL)
Guidelines, Frameworks and Methodologies, and their Application in Mainstream Education

Objectives

The objective of this course is to provide the participants with the necessary knowledge and skills to apply various TESOL methodologies in their teaching and classroom routines in order to broaden their teaching perspectives as well as to improve access, inclusion and achievement for all pupils.

The course will focus on mastering the following knowledge:

- Stepping into the learners' shoes through the unknown language experience
- Building confidence
- Inspiring Learning
- Creating lessons around ideas
- Improve critical thinking through classroom debates and feedback
