

KA1 ERASMUS+ COURSES FOR HEADMASTERS, TEACHERS AND SCHOOL STAFF SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS (SEN)

Objectives

The main objective of the proposed training course is to promote skills to deal with and manage inclusive interventions in educational contexts, regarding the macro area of SEN (Special Educational Needs) and disabilities.

The training provides the necessary skills to:

- learn the general aspects about this issue and specifically in the complex Italian context;
- focus on the differences between “integration”, “inclusion”, “personalization” and “individualization” and their effects in school context;
- elaborate specific aspects of SEN and Learning Disabilities;
- train with the most inclusive teaching methodologies;
- promote personal problem solving abilities on specific SEN situation;
- promote group working skills.

Target groups

The training course is addressed to headmasters, school inspectors, school teachers, VET teachers, VET trainers, and any school education staff who wish to acquire the skills for dealing with special needs in school and classrooms.

The Trainers

The Trainer is an educational psychologist with hands-on experience in school intervention about SEN situations.

Day 1 — 4 hours

General aspects about SEN situation.

Learn about the most important and useful aspects in order to understand the complex Italian context starting with the integration from different points of view: legislative, educational and clinical

Focus on the difference between “integration”, “inclusion”, “personalization” and “individualization” and their effects in school context.

Day 2 — 4 hours

SEN and Learning disabilities.

How to recognize the different types of Special Educational Needs and how to do with them.

How to manage Learning Disabilities.

Day 3 — 4 hours

Inclusive teaching methodologies and group working skills. Deal with the main inclusive teaching methodologies and practice in group works.

Draw from practical work useful indications for group working skills.

Day 4 — 4 hours

Problem solving abilities on specific SEN situations.

Training to practice problem solving abilities on specific SEN and Learning Disabilities situations, starting from the recognition of situation up to the choice of specific interventions from an inclusive point of view.

Day 5 — 4 hours

Visit to a school and networking moments to establish new partnerships. Meeting with teachers and students.
